## CITIZENSHIP APPLICATION SERVICE INCLUDES:

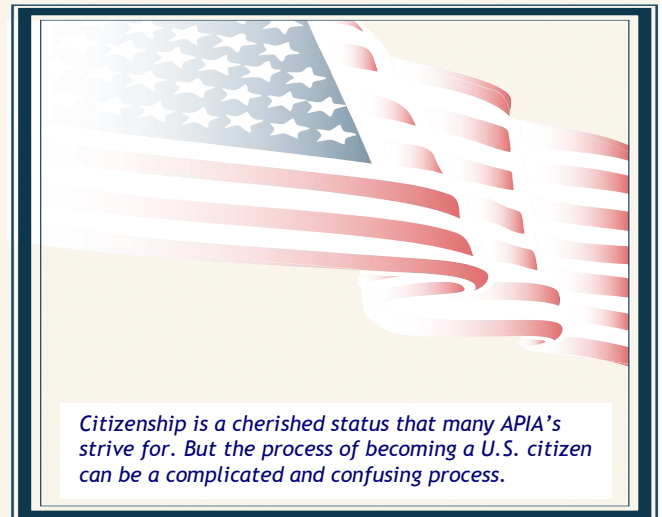
- Providing you with up-to-date information on application requirements and procedures
- Verifying your eligibility for naturalization
- Assisting you with the completion of your citizenship application or other necessary forms
- Filing your application with USCIS (formerly the INS)
- Providing you with helpful study aids for the citizenship examination
- Answering any questions you may have about citizenship

## THE SERVICE DOES NOT INCLUDE:

- Follow up with USCIS in case of slow service, missed appointments, etc.
- Representation at interviews and/or oath ceremonies

## WE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO REFUSE SERVICE TO ANYONE WHO:

- Is not qualified for citizenship
- Has a criminal history that requires a substantial expenditure of resources to resolve
- Is uncooperative with our requests for necessary information
- Fails to provide complete and accurate information
